Behavioral Expectations

Students of drivers education agree to the following:

- 1) BE ON TIME. A student should be in his/her assigned seat and ready to work when the class begins.

- 2) CLEAN UP YOUR MESS. All garbage should be thrown in the garbage cans in the back of the classroom before a student leaves for the day.

- 3) RUDE BEHAVIOR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. When dealing with the instructor and classmates, a student needs to act as a mature young adult who displays self-control and self discipline.

- 4) DO NOT MOVE FROM YOUR ASSIGNED SEATS. When class is in session, a student needs to be in his/her assigned seat.

- 5) NO EARPODS OR CELL PHONE USE. Earpods and cell phones should be put away unless the instructor has given permission to use them.

Continual failure to follow the expectations listed above will result in a student being sent home from that day's class which can be made up in the next upcoming class provided that there is room in that session.
